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Purpose



Approaches to Clinical Inquiry




Workshop held three times, once at Duke Hospital, Duke Regional, & Duke Raleigh

- Idea development from clinical inquiry
- Question formulation using PICO format
- Differentiation of project type
- Literature searching led by librarians
- 30 nurses attended first workshop on March 3, 2017
- Ranged in age, educational degree, years of work experience
- Variety of inpatient-outpatient areas represented
- 100% of attendees indicated learning needs were met

Approaches to Project Development & Implementation



Workshop held twice, once at Duke Hospital & Duke Raleigh. Duke Regional will be July, 2018.

- Literature appraisal
- Formalize outcomes and measurements
- Project design and implementation
- Regulatory processes
- Dissemination
- Paired with coaches a nurse and a librarian
- 7 nurses & 1 dietitian attended workshop on October 2, 2017. Of these, 50% attended #1.
- Ranged in age, educational degree, years of work experience
- Variety of inpatient-outpatient areas represented
- 100% of attendees indicated learning needs were met
