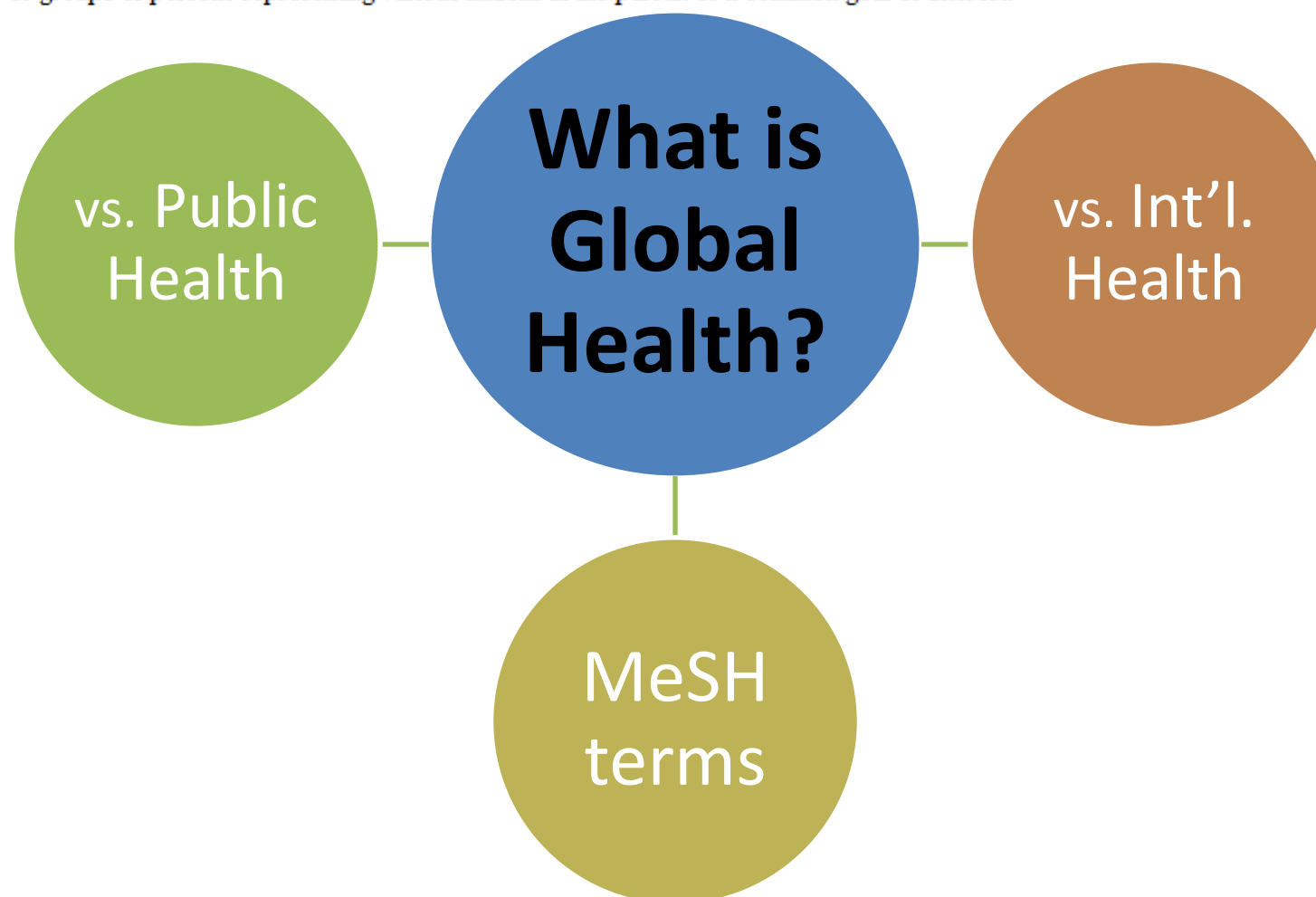



- Locally-hired reference librarian
- Up-to-date and organized print reference collection focused on clinical medicine, infectious diseases, HIV/AIDS, epidemiology, and maternal/child health
- Small, current print journal collection with an emphasis on infectious diseases
- Four computers with open high-speed internet access through a dedicated VSAT
- An array of organized online resources and research tools

Starting with RDU, but plans to expand

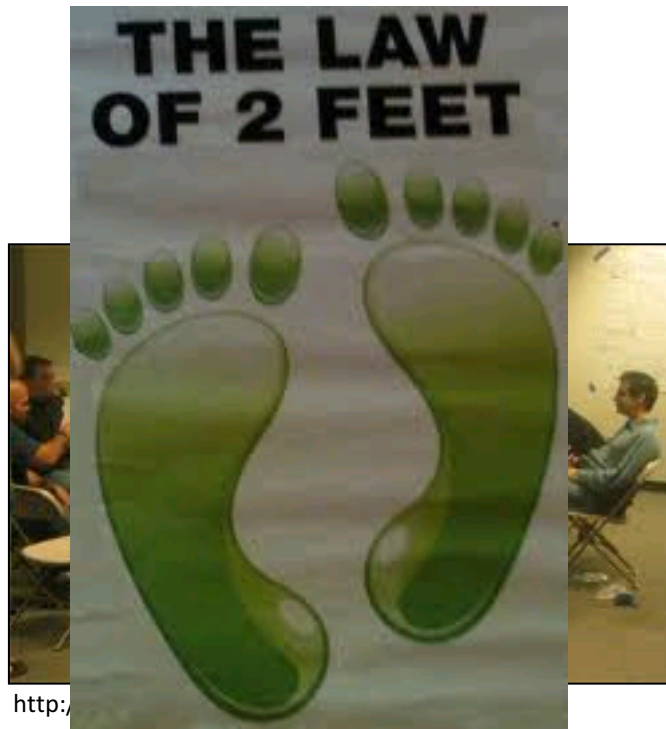
We're planning an un-Conference!
