EXTERNSHIPS

STUDENT ASSISTANTSHIP PROGRAM, TUCSON

THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY MEDICINE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA, TUCSON, HAS AVAILABLE A PROGRAM OF STUDENT ASSISTANTSHIPS FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN FULL-TIME RESEARCH PROJECTS RELATING TO FAMILY PRACTICE. ANY SUBJECT TIME RESEARCH PROJECTS RELATING TO FAMILY PRACTICE. ANY SUBJECT RELEVANT TO FAMILY PRACTICE, UTILIZING THE DISCIPLINARY TOOLS OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY MEDICINE, MAY BE RESEARCHED. ILLUSTRATIVE TOPIC AREAS INCLUDE: GERIATRICS, PATIENT EDUCATION, MEDICAL ANTHROPOLOGY, HEALTH CARE MAINTENANCE, NUTRITION, OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH, EPIDEMIOLOGY, RURAL HEALTH, LEGISLATIVE AND POLICY ISSUES, PREVENTIVE MEDICINE IN OFFICE PRACTICE, UNDERSERVED AREAS/ PEOPLE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

The period of study under the assistantships will range from \$ to 12 weeks. A stipend of \$100 per week will be provided. APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS WHO WISH TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ONE OF THESE AWARDS. THE APPLICATIONS MAY BE SUBMITTED AT ANY DEPOSITE ALTHOUGH FUNDS ARE LIMITED AND EARLY APPLICATION IS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.

CLERKSHIP IN ADOLESCENT HEALTH CARE

THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL NATIONAL MEDICAL CENTER IN WASHINGTON, D.C. IS INVITING SENIOR MEDICAL STUDENTS TO APPLY FOR A CLINICAL CLERKSHIP IN ADOLESCENT HEALTH CARE, ELECTIVE CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN FOR THE CLERKSHIP, WHICH WILL COVER A FOUR TO EIGHT WEEK PERIOD.

THE DEPARTMENT OF ADOLESCENT MEDICINE OF CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL NATIONAL MEDICAL CENTER IS FUNDED BY THE CENTRAL OFFICE OF DHEW AS A MODEL TRAINING PROGRAM IN ADOLESCENT HEALTH CARE, AND OFFERS WELL-SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN DIAGNOSIS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE CLINICAL PROBLEMS OF ADOLESCENTS. CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL IS THE DEPARTMENT OF CHILD HEALTH OF THE GEORGE WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY MEDICAL SCHOOL, AND IS NEWLY LOCATED IN ONE OF THE LARGEST, MOST MODERN FACILITIES IN THE COUNTRY.

THE PURPOSE OF THE CLINICAL CLERKSHIP IS TO ACQUAINT THE MEDICAL STUDENT WITH THE DISCIPLINE OF ADOLESCENT MEDICINE, INCLUDING SPECIFIC NEEDS AND PROBLEMS OF THE ADOLESCENT IN HEALTH AND DISEASE. THE APPROPRIATE MANAGEMENT OF ADOLESCENTS WITH ORGANIC DISEASE REQUIRES AN APPRECIATION OF EMOTIONAL_FACTORS WHICH MUST FORM PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE CARE PLAN. THE STUDENT PROVIDES PRIMARY CARE WITH THE ADVICE AND SUPPORT OF A MULTIDISCIPLINARY CARE TEAM.

TO BE ELIGIBLE, A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FROM THE STUDENT'S DEAN OR CHAIRMAN OF DEPARTMENT OF PEDIATRICS IS ALL THAT IS NEEDED. SHORTAGE OF SPACE PREVENTS ACCEPTANCE OF MORE THAN ONE STUDENT AT A TIME. THEREFORE, EARLY APPLICATION IS ADVISED.

SCHWAPTZ AWARD

THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF LEGAL MEDICINE IS NOW ACCEPTING ORIGINAL PAPERS FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE 1980 SCHWARTZ AWARD, GIVEN ANNUALLY TO THE MEDICAL STUDENT AUTHORING THE OUTSTANDING PAPER ON THE SUBJECT OF LEGAL MEDICINE. THE AWARD CARRIES A \$250 CASH HONOR-ARIUM; THE PAPER WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR PUBLICATION IN THE JOURNAL OF LEGAL MEDICINE OR IN LAMP; AND THE AUTHOR'S EXPENSES WILL BE PAID TO ATTEND THE 1980 INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON LEGAL MEDICINE TO BE HELD AT THE HOUSTON MAKS, HOUSTON, TEXAS, MAY 14-17, 1980.

CASH AWARDS OF \$250 AND \$150 RESPECTIVELY WILL BE GIVEN TO THE PAPERS PLACING SECOND AND THIRD. PLACING SECOND AND THIRD.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS. AUTHORS MUST BE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN AN ACCREDITED MEDICAL SCHOOL IN THE UNITED STATES OR CANADA. NO PAPER WHICH HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY PUBLISHED IN ANY FORM WILL BE CONSIDERED.

CONTENTS. PAPERS MUST CONTAIN ONLY UNCOLLABORATED ORIGINAL WORK. THEY MAY EITHER RELATE TO RESEARCH DONE BY THE AUTHOR OR MAY BE PRESENTED IN ESSAY FORM. PAPERS MAY DEAL WITH ANY ASPECT OF LEGAL MEDICINE.

FORMAT. PAPERS MUST BE NO LESS THAN 3,000 WORDS IN LENGTH. CITATIONS MUST BE GIVEN IN STANDARD FORM AND APPEAR AT THE END OF THE PAPER. PAPERS MUST BE TYPED, DOUBLE-SPACE, ON 8% X 11 WHITE BOND PAPER WITH ONE INCH MARGINS. THE AUTHOR'S NAME AND LOCAL TELEPHONE CONTACT MUST APPEAR ON THE TITLE PAGE; AUTHOR'S NAME, ADDRESS AND SCHOOL MUST APPEAR ON THE FINAL PAGE; AUTHOR'S INITIALS MUST APPEAR IN THE LOWER LEFT HAND CORNER OF ALL OTHER PAGES.

JUDGING, ALL PAPERS WILL BE JUDGED BY THE STUDENT AWARDS COMMITTEE OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF LEGAL MEDICINE, AND THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL. RECIPIENTS WILL BE INFORMED NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 1980 AND AWARDS PRESENTED DURING THE 20TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON LEGAL MEDICINE TO BE HELD MAY 14-17, 1980, IN TEXAS.

FINANCIAL AID

IN THE PAST SOME STUDENTS WITH U.S. HEALTH PROFESSIONS LOANS WERE ABLE TO HAVE PART OF THEIR LOANS CANCELLED IN RETURN FOR PRACTICE IN A HEALTH MANPOWER SHORTAGE AREA. EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1979, APPLICATIONS ARE NO LONGER BEING ACCEPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEV, HEALTH RESOURCES ADMINISTRATION, FOR THIS PROGRAM. THE REASON FOR THIS IS THAT THE FEDERAL FUNDS USED FOR THIS PROGRAM ARE NO LONGER AVAILABLE.
