ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION NIG 31 10 OF WHE AMERICAN REGISTRY OF PHYSICIANS' ASSOCIATES, INC.

- Paragraph 4 of the original Articles of Incorporation of the corporation should be amended to read:
 - 4. Membership in this corporation shall be of three classifications as follows:
 - a) Active members: Active members of this corporation shall be representatives of educational institutions with training programs for physician dependent personnel, which programs satisfy the criteria to be set forth in the By-Laws and which are in active operation and have graduated students. Active members shall be entitled to attend meetings of the corporate membership and shall be entitled to vote.
 - b) Associate members: Associate members of this corporation shall be representatives of educational institutions with training programs for physician dependent personnel, which programs satisfy the criteria to be set forth in the By-Laws and which are in active operation but have not graduated students. Associate members shall be entitled to attend meetings of the corporate membership and shall be entitled to yote.
 - c) Provisional members: Provisional members of this corporation shall be representatives of educational institutions which have developed a plan for a training program for physician dependent personnel which satisfies the criteria to be set forth in the By-Laws and have designated a person to effectuate the plan, but which is not in active operation. Provisional members shall be entitled to attend meetings of the corporate membership but shall not be entitled to vote, except that such provisional members shall be entitled to vote during the first year of the operation of this corporation which shall be deemed to end on the second Friday of July, 1971.
- The American Registry of Physicians' Associates, Inc., a corporation of North Carolina, doth hereby certify that on the 10th day of July, 1970, at the

first meeting of the members of this corporation, all members being present, the above-stated amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation was approved by unanimous vote of the members, such amendment having been referred to the members by a resolution unanimously adopted by the Board of Directors.

Articles of Incorporation

of

The American Registry of Physicians' Associates, Inc.

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act," and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

- The name of the corporation is THE AMERICAN REGISTRY OF PHYSICIANS' ASSOCIATES, INC.
- 2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
 - (a) To encourage the training and to promote and regulate the activities of Physicians' Associates;
 - (b) To elevate the standards of Physicians' Associates by improving their training;
 - (c) To determine the competence of Physicians' Associates and to arrange, control and conduct investigations and examinations to test the qualifications of voluntary candidates for certificates to be issued by the corporation;
 - (d) To grant and issue certificates to Physicians' Associates who voluntarily apply therefor, and to maintain a Registry of holders of such certificates;
 - (e) To serve physicians by preparing and furnishing lists of Physicians' Associates who shall have been certified by the corporation;
 - (f) To do and perform all things necessary to the foregoing specified purposes, including the acquisition of property both real and personal by purchase or lease, the employment of personnel, contracting for courses of instruction, the establishment of schools and places of training, negotiations with agencies of the County, State and Federal Governments, and generally to perform all acts incidental to the successful legal operation of this organization.
