REHABILITATION MEDICINE / MEDICAL COLLEGE OF VIRGINIA

THE DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION MEDICINE, MEDICAL COLLEGE OF VIRGINIA, IS OFFERING A TWO MONTH CLINICAL TRAINEESHIP FOR STUDENTS FINISHING THE FIRST, SECOND OR THIRD YEAR OF MEDICAL SCHOOL. THE TRAINEESHIP EXTENDS FROM MID-JUNE THROUGH MID-AUGUST 1980. THIS EXTERNSHIP IS SPONSORED BY A HEW GRANT WITH A STIPEND OF \$325.00 PER MONTH, LODGING WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE MEDICAL COLLEGE AT A COST OF \$88.50 PER MONTH. A ONE MONTH TRAINEESHIP DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR (NOVEMBER THROUGH MAY) IS ALSO BEING OFFERED FOR JUNIOR AND SENIOR STUDENTS.
