
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# **Engel Collection Purpose**

- NY Times, Amazon, etc. reviews




# Genres

- 7 continued, 1new
- 7 dropped
- Low usage
- Photography, Travel,
- Music/Art, Religion
- + High usage
- Fiction, Political.
- How-to (in recent years)

- Narrative Creative Non-fiction
- History
- Autobiography
- Science
- Biography
- Essay
- Philosophy/ethics


# Why Study the Collection?


- Focus on data driven acquisitions
- Emphasis on patron driven needs/preferences
- Fewer funds for non-medical texts
- Alignment with user needs, interests

### **Study Method**

- Circulation and publication data
- High/low usage and publication dates.
- 4 1 genre, analyzed primary topic

### **Conclusions**

- Fewer genres & topics recently selected
  - Older ones out of scope
- Selection aligned with user preferences
- No impact if multiple campus copies
- Focus on Duke Medicine ease of access
- Reconsider selecting fiction
- Stop collecting self-help titles
