SUBJECT: AMA Site Visit, May 15-16

The purpose of this memorandum is to give you a brief progress report on the AMA site visit on May 15 and 16. I am enclosing with this memorandum a copy of the schedule for the two-day site visit, and as you mentioned to me in your letter of May 4, we indeed did have problems getting some of the clinical directors from the Medical Center to meet with the site visit team because of the Quail Roost meetings. However, we were very fortunate in that Drs. Jim Nuckolls, John Laszlo, Lois Pounds, and John Tindall were able to spend a great deal of time with the site visit team on Tuesday, May 16.

At the conclusion of the two-day site visit, I spent a few moments with Drs. Harvey and Fauser, and they both seemed well satisfied that the schedule which we had arranged for them gave them an opportunity to obtain an indepth look into our Physician's Associate Program at Duke University.

I believe that the most worthwhile period of time they spent here at Duke was on their tour through the Clinical settings of the Veterans Administration and Duke Hospitals with Mr. Paul Toth and Mr. John McQueary, when the members of the site visit team had the opportunity to see physician's associates in the various clinical areas.

Dr. John Fauser, the representative from the American Medical Association, informed me that they would recommend to the Committee that our Program be certified and that we would probably receive formal notification of this action after September 12, 1972.
