GRADUATE STUDENTS SEEKING HOUSING IN DURHAM: Temporary accommodations from June 10-August 25, 1970, will be made available to accepted graduate level students who must come to Durham to seek living accommodations for the academic year 1970-71. A third floor section of the Graduate Center located at Erwin Road and Trent Drive has been reserved for couples with or without children who need economical accommodations while seeking permanent housing for the Fall. A charge has been established at fifty cents per night per bed, payable to Duke University. Accommodations will be made available for a maximum of ten days only without approval of the Department of Housing Management. The residence hall is not airconditioned and fans cannot be provided. Accommodations will be clean and economical but please do not expect to find luxury. These arrangements are provided to assist you.
