APPLICATIONS FOR LOAN REPAYMENT FOR SERVICE IN A SHORTAGE AREA

As of October 1, 1977, the Student Assistance Branch, Bureau of Health Manpower, is no longer accepting applications for Health Professions Loan Repayment for Service in a Shortage Area. Applications for Nursing Loan Repayment are still being accepted.

On August 1, 1977, the Health Planning and Health Services Research and Statistics Extension Act of 1977 (PL 95-38) was signed by the President. This legislation provided that other professional educational loans made prior to October 1, 1976, were eligible for repayment in addition to federally financed health professions loans. Due to this enactment, the Bureau has received an increased number of applications which has resulted in a total commitment of funds allocated for FY1978. Although no funds remain for new applications, it is possible that additional funds for this fiscal year may be made available.

In accordance with the Health Professions Educational Assistance Act of 1976, the published health professions shortage area lists previously in use expired September 30, 1977. New criteria and lists are now being developed. We will notify you of future developments.

TEAM APPROACH TO HEALTH CARE

Faculty from Duke are presently involved in an experimental team approach to health care in southern Durham County. The staff members of Southern Health Care described and promoted their program at the "Issues in Health Care" Seminar, part of a series of seminars for first year medical students sponsored by the American Medical Student Association,

on October 20. Their office opened just a few weeks ago at 5124 Revere Road and they serve anyone seeking care. Present staff includes a family physician, family nurse practitioner, counseling psychologist, community facilitator, and an administrator. Southern Health Care is an innovation in local health care services, but more importantly, it may be a place for you and your family to obtain care.


What is team health care? The concept and the reality together represent two major changes. The first is that these staff members with varied training and perspectives are attempting to break down the traditional heirarchy of medical and care professionals. They want to focus attention on the community rather than on internal boundaries. They have institutionalized a system of chart audits by which they cross review records of the people they serve during the week and provide suggestions from their multiple positions and experiences.

The second radical change is the inclusion of the community as part of the team. This is not the usual lip-service given to community concern within a certain geographical area but a real attempt to integrate Southern Health Care into the life of southern Durham County. The Board of Directors, with complete decision-making power over policy and practices, is made up of community members. More importantly, the program wants to build a partnership with the community to maintain health and correct problems through a mutual concern for care, not the common oneway interaction. At Southern Health Care the policy is that primary health care can only be successfuly with the two way team approach. If you live in south Durham County, check them out.
