

SUGGESTED BY-LAWS FOR DUKE CHAPTER OF ALPHA OMEGA ALPHA.

1 - That students shall be eligible for election after completing 10 quarters work in the Duke University Medical School. Exceptions may be allowed for those transferring from other schools on completion of a similar amount of work.

2 - At the beginning of each quarter, with the exception of the summer quarter, a list of all students who qualify will be sent to the members of the medical school faculty with the request that they indicate those whom they recommend for membership in the A. O. A.

3 - The number of undergraduates to be elected in any one year, as specified by the Constitution, shall not be more than 20% of the students completing the work in that year.

4 - The candidate shall be voted upon by the resident faculty and student members as stated in the Constitution:-

"A list of the candidates is, in every case, to be sent to each faculty member of the fraternity with requests for criticisms, and no candidate receiving an adverse criticism from a faculty member shall be balloted upon; such criticism shall, however, be accompanied by an explanation.

Each candidate shall be balloted upon separately, and one negative vote shall be sufficient to exclude, but in every such case the member so voting shall state his reasons in full before the other members. Should this member withdraw his vote, the candidate may be balloted upon at a subsequent meeting."

5 - Initiation shall be once a year, by banquet with invited members from other chapters, to be held in the spring quarter. Upon being elected, members may, by payment of an initiation fee, obtain their key and membership before initiation. This is primarily for those who will be in absentia at initiation time.

6 - Honorary members may be elected as is seen fit, to be nominated by the same election committee.
