PubMed LinkOut Now Available

What is PubMed LinkOut?

PubMed LinkOut is a program sponsored by the National Library of Medicine (NLM) that enables users to link from PubMed citations to the full text of articles or to the summary holdings of the Library's print journal collection.

How do I access LinkOut?

In order to take advantage of the links, you will first need to connect to PubMed using a special URL. To do so, you may select PubMed from the "Databases" dropdown menu on the *DUMCL Online* main page (http://www.mclibrary.duke.edu) or connect directly to PubMed at http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/entrez/query.fcgi?holding=dukemlib.

How will I know whether the full text is available?

Once you have a citation, simply click on the author's name to view the complete PubMed record. Blue DUMCL icons will appear for those citations where the Library offers either print or electronic access, or both. Clicking on the "DUMCL Online" icon will open the full-text article in a separate browser window. The "DUMCL Print" icon provides Library holdings information for the paper version of the journal.

Why do only some citations have DUMCL icons available?

Not all citations in PubMed will have DUMCL icons, because the Library does not subscribe to every journal indexed.



Why don't icons appear on records for which the Library has a journal subscription?

Publishers are responsible for notifying NLM when full text is available. Depending on the provider of the Library's electronic access to a journal, there can be a delay in the availability of a journal's contents. For example, DUMCL subscribes to the *New England Journal of Medicine (NEJM)* through Ovid. Ovid must first get the full text from *NEJM* and then load it onto its own system, before it can finally notify NLM that the full text of an issue is available. This process can delay the appearance of the DUMCL icons in PubMed LinkOut by as much as a week.

Does LinkOut replace using the proxy server?

No. You must still use the proxy server to connect to Duke's electronic journals from off campus.

What is the benefit of using PubMed LinkOut?

The LinkOut feature is a great time saver because it eliminates the step of searching other databases for full-text information, such as the Library Catalog or Journals@Ovid Full Text.

Capturing the Medical Center's History

Since the 1970s, Medical Center Archives has played a vital role in preserving and providing access to the legal, administrative, and historical records of the Medical Center and Health System administrative offices, department chairs and chiefs, and faculty. By preserving the Medical Center's documentary heritage, the Archives makes it possible to study contributions of members to the Medical Center community and the history of the institution. As of this spring, the Archives has approximately 4,000 linear feet of materials from the past seventy years.

Medical Center Archives contains papers of significant personalities including W.C. Davison, Ewald Busse, William Alexander Perlzweig, Francis Huntington Swett, Bessie Baker, and Frederick Moir Hanes. Correspondence, speeches, short

writings, photographs, budgets, oral histories and other materials from these papers allow researchers to follow the professional activities of Duke individuals. Archives also houses many artifacts used in early clinical examinations, including an otoscope, a haemacytometer, blood pressure cuffs, stethoscopes, and gastroscopes. In fact, one of the Archives' recent acquisitions was the doctor's bag of a first-year Duke medical student (1941).

The historical collections in the Archives contain materials documenting the groundbreaking work of Duke medical professionals. The records of the Duke Poison Control Center, directed by Jay Arena and later Shirley K. Osterhout, provide evidence of the Center's international leadership and their involvement in the development of the first childproof safety cap. A collection of materials from the 65th General Hospital, a Duke-affiliated Army medical unit in World War II, includes photographs and reports documenting skilled surgery and wound treatment on the battlefield. Images of buildings, ceremonies and individuals, and shots of news-making events and discoveries comprise the Archives' Photograph Collection. One highlight of the collection is a photograph of the first autopsy performed at Duke.

Medical Center Archives actively collects the official records of DUMC and DUHS departments and divisions, including a variety of materials that provide evidence of their business, interests, and activities over the years. By centralizing materials and relieving individual offices of the responsibility of storing and servicing records, greater and more efficient use of the materials can be promoted. Archives staff are currently meeting with administrators and other department leaders to gather records from under-documented departments and divisions.

The impetus for an archive at Duke University Medical Center was an October 1965 article published in the *Intercom*, the forerunner of the *Duke Dialogue*, entitled "Wait, Please...Before You Throw That Away!" The authors requested that individuals send in their "priceless" materials to become part of the reading room of the new Medical Center Library, devoted to the "History of Duke University Medical Center." Barnes Woodhall, M.D., Vice Provost, and G.S.T. Cavanagh, then Director of the Medical Center Library, coordinated this first formal attempt to collect materials. Three years later, through the support of the Mary Duke Biddle Foundation, Elon Clark, Coordinator and Professor of Medical Art, began collecting official papers, photographs, printed materials, and interviews pertaining to the history and business of the Medical Center. With the support and interest of many Medical Center faculty members, the Archives was formally established in 1977.

Medical Center Archives (http://archives.mc.duke.edu/) is staffed by Russell Koonts, Director and Archivist, Charles Rutt, Reference and Outreach Coordinator, Emily Glenn, Technical Services Coordinator, and Jessica Roseberry, Oral History Program Coordinator.

Authorized users may access the database via Medical Center workstations, but remote access through the proxy server is prohibited. Access is also permitted through Duke Health Enterprise Virtual Private Network (VPN) accounts, but they may only be used on the Medical Center campus.

MLEC Classroom Reservations

The Medical Library Education Center (MLEC) classroom, located in Room 104 on the Lower Level of the Library, is available for reservation by Duke faculty and staff and DUMC students who wish to conduct classes or hands-on training utilizing computer technology.

From August 1 through mid-September, non-library departments may only book the MLEC classroom two weeks in advance of a proposed event. This is to allow for scheduling of Library orientations and other training sessions offered by the Library at the beginning of the academic year. At other times, non-library events may be scheduled up to six months in advance, but reservations are only guaranteed for the two months prior to the event. Events scheduled more than two months in advance may be subject to change. The department will be notified if scheduling changes are necessary. The Library must be notified at least 48 hours in advance of a scheduled event if the MLEC classroom is not going to be used. Otherwise, a \$25 cancellation fee will be charged.
