N.C. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES LOANS

NORTH CAROLINA RESIDENT? THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES, DIVISION OF FACILITY SERVICES, WILL BE HOLDING INTERVIEWS FOR 1980-81 BEGINNING IN JANUARY FOR APPLICANTS TO THEIR LOAN PROGRAM. THESE LOANS ARE FOR \$6,000,000 YEARLY. YOU MUST BE A MORTH CAROLINA RESIDENT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION INCLUDE INTEREST, ACADEMIC ABILITY, MOTIVATION TO PRACTICE IN A MEDICALLY UNDERSERVED AREA AS DEFINED BY THE MEDICAL CARE COMMISSION, AND FINANCIAL AID NEED.

REPAYMENT: LOANS ARE CANCELLED ON THE BASIS OF MEDICAL PRACTICE IN UNDERSERVED AREAS OF THE STATE; CASH REPAYMENT MUST BE MADE UPON DEMAND IF THE RECIPIENT BREACHES THIS CONTRACT,

CLERKSHIPS AT U.C.S.F.

SCHOLARSHIPS

PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATES FOR RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS, 1979

THE RHODES COMPETITION IS OPEN TO BOTH MEN AND WOMEN. DUKE AND OTHER UNIVERSITIES, AT THE REQUEST OF THE RHODES TRUSTEES, HAVE FORMED COMMITTEES "COMPETENT TO COMMENT ON THE RELATIVE MERITS OF PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATES". THE CURRENT RHODES MEMORANDUM TO PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATES REQUESTS THEM TO ASK SUCH COMMITTEES TO PREPARE EVALUATIVE STATEMENTS ON THEIR BEHALF. IT ALSO STATES THAT A CANDIDATE'S APPLICATION WILL BE CONSIDERED BY THE STATE COMMITTEE OF SELECTION WHETHER OR NOT AN EVALUATIVE STATEMENT IS RECEIVED FROM A CAMPUS COMMITTEE.

DUKE STUDENTS (UNDERGRADUATES AND GRADUATES) WHO WISH THE CAMPUS COMMITTEE TO SEND AN EVALUTATION IN THEIR BEHALF MUST SUBMIT A "PRE-APPLICATION" BY OCTOBER 1, 1979 TO THE OFFICE OF DEAN ELLEN WITTIG, 106 ALLEN BUILDING. THE PRE-APPLICATION SHOULD CONTAIN:

(I) A TRANSCIPT OF COLLEGE ACADEMIC WORK; (II) A LIST OF PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES AND HONORS WHILE IN COLLEGE; (III) A COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S PERSONAL ESSAY (A CONNECTED STATEMENT OF GENERAL ACTIVITIES AND INTELLECTUAL INTERESTS IN COLLEGE AND PROPOSED LINE OF STUDY AT OXFORD" NOT TO EXCEED 1,000 WORDS IN LENGTH); (IV) THREE LETTERS OF REFERENCE.

EACH APPLICANT, WHETHER OR NOT A PRE-APPLICATION IS FILED, WILL THEN COMPLETE HIS/HER FORMAL APPLICATION AND SUBMIT IT TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE SELECTION COMMITTEE BEFORE THE DEADLINE OF OCTOBER 31, 1979.



WOMEN PHYSICIANS IN COMTEMPORARY SOCIETY


THE MARY ELIZABETH GARRETT SYMPOSIUM, "WOMEN PHYSICIANS IN CONTEMPORARY SOCIETY", WILL BE HELD AT THE JOHN HOPKINS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE ON OCTOBER 9-10. 1979. THE PRESENTATIONS AND PANEL DISCUSSIONS TO BE INCLUDED WILL FOCUS ON SUCH TOPICS AS "WOMAN, M.D. - A CONTEMPORARY PROFILE', "WOMEN PHYSICIANS IN THE SYSTEM", "THE INTERACTIONS OF WOMEN PHYSICIANS WITH SOCIETY', "WOMAN, M.D. - PERCEPTIONS AND REALITIES', AND "CHOICES IN PROFESSIONAL AND PRIVATE LIFE".

TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE 16,000 STUDENTS ENTERING MEDICAL SCHOOL IN THE COUNTRY THIS YEAR WILL BE WOMEN. THEY WILL JOIN THE 38,000 WOMEN ALREADY IN PRACTICE, ABOUT 10% OF THE NATION'S DOCTORS. THIS TWO-DAY CONFERENCE WILL EXPLORE THE IMPLICATIONS AND IMPACT OF INCREASING NUMBERS OF WOMEN PHYSICIANS AND THE CHANGES UNDERWAY IN THEIR PROFESSIONAL ROLES, CAREER CHOICES, EDUCATIONAL EXPECTATIONS, AND PRIVATE LIVES.

REGISTRATION FOR THE SYMPOSIUM WILL BE FROM 8:00-9:00 AM ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9, IN THE LOWER CONCOURSE OF THE TURNER AUDITORIUM. THERE IS A REGISTRATION FEE OF \$40,00 (special rates are available for students). Rooms have been reserved for symposium participants at the Sheraton-Johns Hopkins Inn and the Cross Keys Inn.
