## RURAL HEALTH COALITION

THE NORTH CAROLINA STUDENT RURAL HEALTH COALITION WILL HOLD ITS ORIENTATION MEETING ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 9TH, AT 7:00 PM AT THE EAST CAMPUS STUDENT ACTIVITIES HOUSE.

THE STUDENT-RUN COALITION SPONSORS HEALTH FAIRS IN RURAL AREAS OF NORTH CAROLINA TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF LOCAL HEALTH CARE. IN ADDITION, SPECIAL PROJECTS ADDRESS THE HEALTH NEEDS OF MIGRANT WORKERS. STUDENTS WILL LIVE AND WORK IN ONE (OR MORE) OF MANY SMALL COMMUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE STATE FOR SIX WEEKS DURING THE MONTHS OF JULY AND AUGUST, PERFORMING PHYSICAL EXAMS AND PARTICIPATING IN HEALTH SERVICES ORGANIZATION.
