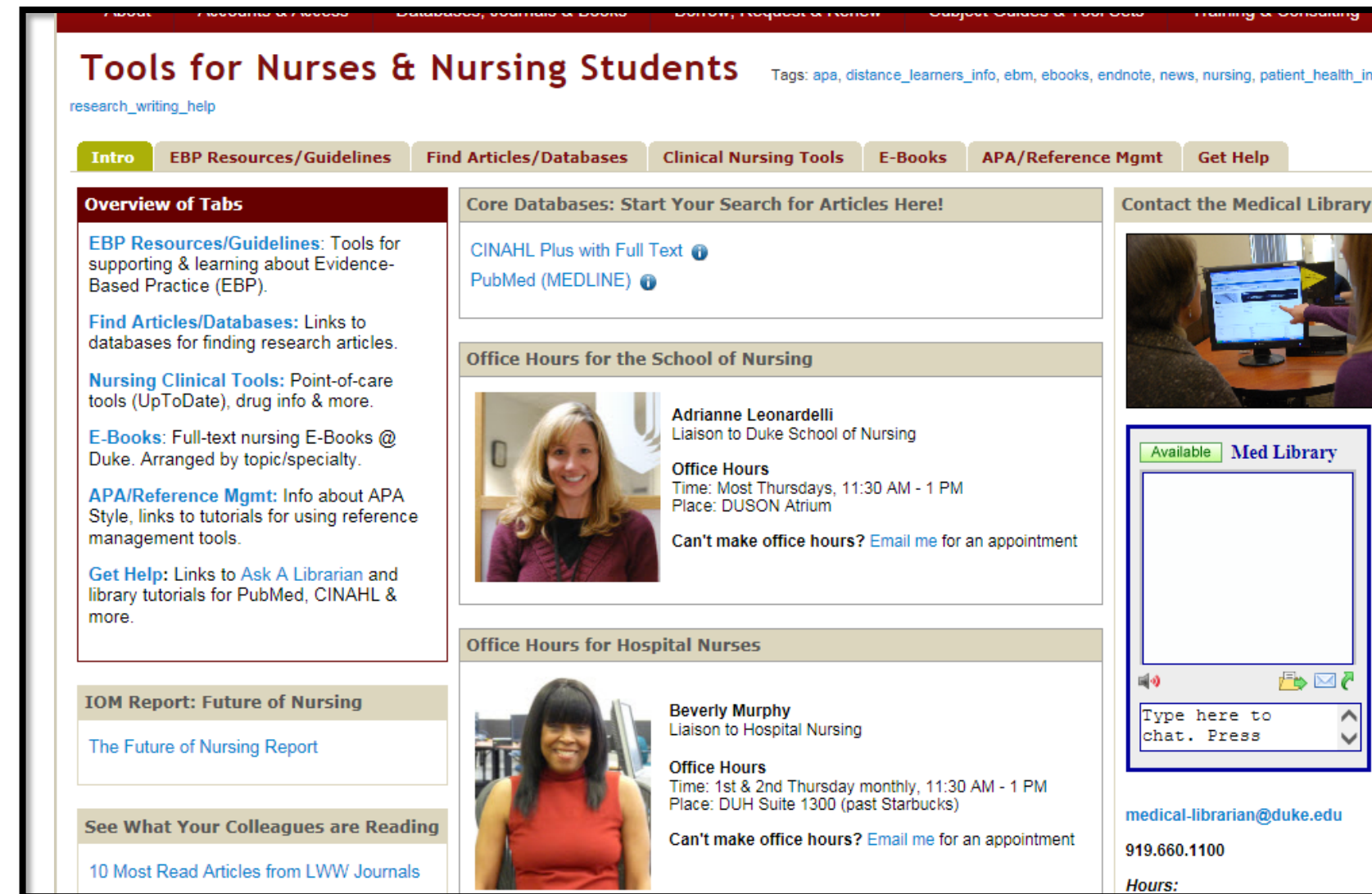
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Strengthening Foundations

- ❖ Strengthened role of Library Liaison at School of Nursing (SON)
- ❖ Office hours onsite
- ❖ Instruction for orientations, EBP classes, etc.
- ❖ Creates video tutorials for distance education courses
- ❖ Research consultations with students, faculty & staff
- ❖ Attends faculty meetings and SON open house events
- ❖ Performs in-depth literature searches for faculty
- ❖ Collaborates with faculty on systematic reviews
- ❖ Participates in research projects (focus groups, etc.)
- ❖ Co-authors articles with faculty
- ❖ Conducted analysis comparing library holdings to required or recommended course textbooks
