FAMILY PRACTICE AND COMMUNITY MEDICINE - The College of Medicine at the University of Illinois announces residencies in family practice and community medicine at Abraham Lincoln School of Medicine, Peoria School of Medicine, and Rockford School of Medicine. SAMA-EATON MEDICAL ART AWARDS - The Student American Medical Association announces the 15th Annual SAMA-EATON Medical Art Awards competition. Although the program is primarily designed to encourage the use of medical graphics among medical students, entries may be submitted by anyone in the health care field. Prizes will be awarded to top entries in the following categories: medical photography, photomicrography, electron photomicrography, photo essay (non-scientific), medical illustration. The 1973 award competition will present cash prizes and plaques to first, second and third prize winners in medical photography, medical illustration and photo essay. First and second prizes in photomicrography and a first prize in electron photomicrography will be presented.
