M.D.'S AND R.N.'S - SUMMER JOB OPPORTUNITY, BERKSHIRE MOUNTAINS, MASS.: The following job opportunities are available at Camp Greylock for Boys in Becket, Massachusetts and Camp Romaca for Girls in Hinsdale, Massachusetts:

Both Camps: Licensed Medical Doctor for July and August to supervise our camp infirmary. We seek the services of a Doctor who can be with us for the 8 week camping season - or two (2) Doctors, one for July and the second for August. Family accommodations are available. Salary is negotiable.

Camp Greylock: Three (3) Registered Nurses for the entire 8 week camping season, to arrive on or around June 25th-26th. The three R.N.'s will share duties, thus providing a very fair amount of time off to enjoy the camp activities and the music/art/craftsman cultural activities of the nearby area. Salary, including room, board and laundry is \$550.00, plus travel allowance if needed, for the camping season.

Camp Romaca: Two (2) Registered Nurses for the entire 8 week camping season, to arrive on or around June 26th. Two R.N.'s will share duties, thus providing a very fair amount of time off to enjoy the camp activities and the music/art/craftsman cultural activities of the nearby area. Salary, including room, board and laundry is \$550.00, plus \$100.00 travel allowance, for the camping season.

It is not necessary to wear nurse uniforms at any time - dress at camp is most informal and comfortable with shorts, dungarees and pants being worn, depending on the weather. Greylock is an all boys' camp with 100 male staff and approximately 12 female staff. Romaca is an all girls' camp with 125 campers (age 7-16) with a staff of 35. There are many boys' camps in the immediate area. You may bring your car to either of these camps. You will live in a modern camp infirmary. The weather and working conditions are most pleasant and, of course, the Berkshire area is a music and art cultural center. Kindly apply to:
